

**DUBLIN SCIOTO TOUCHDOWN CLUB  
MEETING MINUTES**

**March 28, 2016**

**I. CALL TO ORDER**

Devanie Gossett called the meeting of the Dublin Scioto Touchdown Club to order at approximately 7:05 pm on March 28, 2016, at Dublin Scioto High School.

The following officers and coaches were in attendance: Head Coach Karl Johnson, President Devanie Gossett, Vice-President Alesha Densel, Treasurer Rick Gray and Secretary Lisa Gray. All parents in attendance (about 20) were asked to introduce themselves.

**III. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**President's Report**

Devanie Gossett talked about the need to fill the remaining open positions. These include: Spirit Wear, Vice Treasurer, Davis Middle School Liaison, Game Night Set-Up, Summer Concessions and Pre/Post Game Gatorade. Anyone interested in volunteering should contact Devanie or Coach Johnson.

**Treasurer's Report.**

Rick Gray provided an overview of the budget and shared the major areas of fundraising. Gray mentioned that last year, for the first time ever, the Touchdown Clubs receipts exceeded \$100,000. Expenses were approximately \$85,000, but there is an outstanding expense for \$10,000 to cover the costs of the stadium seats. Bill Hutras, 20 for 20 Campaign Director wants the expense paid by May 1, 2016. Hutras also mentioned that we need to continue to raise capital funds to cover the costs of the stadium seats. The 2016-2017 Touchdown Club budget will be presented at the next meeting for adoption.

**Pancake Breakfast**

The Second Annual Pancake breakfast is scheduled for Saturday, August 20, 2016, from 8:00 am to Noon. The breakfast will feature introductions of the Davis Middle School and Scioto High School Football teams and coaches, as well as the cheer squads from both schools. In addition, there will be a 50/50 raffle, silent auction and a pancake eating contest. The cost is \$10 per person, with children 4 and under free and includes all you can eat pancakes, sausages, coffee and orange drink. **Coach's Report**

Karl announced that summer camp begins on June 13, 2016, and weekly summer lifting will be held on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Fridays from 7:00 am to 9:00 am. Karl also mentioned that there are a number of camps available for the boys to attend. Camps mentioned included Ohio State (3 day and single day), Otterbein (Lauren First and Goal – a fundraiser for the West Point Coach's daughter who suffers from cancer) and FBU. Karl also talked about the college recruiting process and reiterated the most important element for recruiting are strong academics and good grades.
